



## My 21 Rules SDLC >> Requirements Package Template

Type	Description
<b>Feature</b>	Functionality of the system.
<b>Reporting</b>	Reporting needs.
<b>Integration</b>	Requirements related to systems integration.
<b>Performance</b>	Requirements for system attributes like response time, reliability, availability, durability.
<b>Process</b>	Processes needed to support the system. Auditing or approval processes are examples.
<b>Migration</b>	Transitioning from one system to another.
<b>Maintenance</b>	Requirements to support the system once in use. Examples include tuning and patching, archiving, upgrades, new features, bug fixes.
<b>Compliance</b>	Regulatory, policy and supporting audit requirements.
Status	Description
<b>Proposed</b>	A specified requirement that has yet to be approved.
<b>Approved</b>	A reviewed and approved requirement.
<b>Implemented</b>	A requirement that has been created in the system.
<b>Verified</b>	A requirement that has been confirmed to function as specified in the approved requirement.
<b>Deferred</b>	An approved requirement that is not yet scheduled for implementation.
<b>Rejected</b>	A requirement that has been reviewed but not approved.
<b>Obsolete</b>	A requirement that is no longer needed and was not implemented.

<b>High</b>	Must have
<b>Medium</b>	Should have
<b>Low</b>	Nice to have
S.M.A.R.T.	Description
<b>S</b>	Specific
<b>M</b>	Measurable
<b>A</b>	Attainable
<b>R</b>	Relevant
<b>T</b>	Time-bound
